#### International Projects 105CE - Diabetes awareness

One Person is Diagnosed Every Two Minutes.

There are around 5 million people with diabetes in the UK, which is 1 in 15 people.

Around 90% of people with diabetes have type 2 diabetes. Around 8% of people with diabetes have type 1 diabetes. About 2% of people with diabetes have rarer types of diabetes.

Fundraising has helped Diabetes UK support those living with diabetes and their families. They have reached over 75,000 people with their "Learning Zone" courses, with 83% of users saying they are more confident managing their diabetes.

Aided frontline service support, "Learning Zone" support line and the website (online resource materials) provide access to those who require it most.


Fellow Lions, have you supported the diabetes cause lately? How about donating or having a fundraising event for this good cause. It's Lions International project and one of the five global causes.

#### Leigh on Sea Lions Club, 18th & 19th May.


